- You are required to attend both audition dates: December 16th and December 17th both at 1:30 pm
  - The first day of auditions of December 16th, you will be taught a ballet, modern, and jazz combination (prepare accordingly)
  - The second day of auditions on December 17th, you will be taught repertory from different choreographers
- If chosen for Camryn Stafford's piece you will be participating in a week-long residency:
  - o December 16th from 4 pm 6 pm
  - O December 17th from 4 pm 6 pm
  - December 18th-20th from 2:00 pm 6:00 pm
- If chosen for "Face what's facing you" choreographed by Claude Alexander III, you will be participating in a residency from January 13th to January 17th (times TBD)
- If chosen for a piece you are committing to all rehearsals scheduled by the choreographer
- You are required to be at all rehearsals ON TIME
- You are required to communicate any conflicts to your choreographer
- You must be passing in order to be determined eligible to perform
- You are required to be at the tech rehearsal on April 22, the dress rehearsal on April 23rd, and the show which will take place on April 24th
